OFFICE BEARERS' RESOLUTION(S)

We, the undersigned, being the committee members of SYAMA (Society of the Youth for Artistic Music Appreciation) _____ on this day, RESOLVE as follow :-

CHANGE OF OBJECTS

Resolved that subject to the approval of the Registrar of Societies, the Object of the society in the constitution be changed to :

1. To cultivate a conducive and motivating environment for the practice of Indian carnatic and Hindustani music and Indian dance through concerts, workshops, ensembles and master-classes.
2. To develop aspiring young Indian musicians and dancers to reach performance standards of the level of international artistes.
3. To promote and support the works of Singapore young Indian musicians and dancers
4. To collaborate with non-indian musicians/dancers/organizations in Singapore, thereby sharing knowledge and to get Indian music and dance appreciated by a wider audience.

CHANGE OF 'APPLICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP'

Resolved that subject to the approval of the Registrar of Societies, the Object of the society in the constitution be changed to:

1. Plenary membership is applicable only for those who have contributed significantly to the society, and will be through invitation, after the approval of a minimum 2/3rds of the management committee.

CHANGE OF 'ENTRANCE FEES, SUBSCRIPTIONS AND OTHER DUES'

Resolved that subject to the approval of the Registrar of Societies, the Object of the society in the constitution be changed to:

1. Annual subscriptions are payable as follows:
 - a. Plenary member: S\$100
 - b. Associate member: S\$100

Resolved that the societies music lessons are henceforth available to only members and their children. For all current students below the age of 18, one of the parents should register as an associate member. For students above the age of 18, either the student or a parent should register as an associate member.
